

High School Appeals Process

A student who wishes to be considered for an honors course must be identified as gifted in the specific academic discipline via the School Town of Munster's high ability achievement and ability placement tests. In addition, student performance on standardized assessments will be reviewed. High school students who meet the criteria of attaining the 96th percentile on any of these assessments may elect to attempt to test into a specific honors class. These tests are given at the high school and are scheduled through the Guidance Office. Students attempting to test into an honors course at Munster High School must score 80% or above to be placed into the class.
